- The ideal time frame for alterations is 2-3 months. Start researching seamstresses and booking your fittings as soon as you have an estimated arrival time for your gown (provided by your stylist approximately 1-2 weeks after order date). Please schedule ASAP if you will have less than 2 months for alterations.
- It is extremely important that you feel confident and comfortable with the seamstress you choose. When choosing who to work with, ask for referrals from wedding professionals, friends and family. Read reviews and discuss your desires and expectations with the seamstress before booking.
